### WEB DESIGN / FRONTEND DEVELOPMENT

- Web design from concept to production. Collaboration following Agile principles. Used responsive frameworks. Created WordPress themes.
- Built intuitive forms and UI using JavaScript and JQuery. Guerilla usability testing and prototyping. Developed ecommerce platform and created streamlined forms for account payments, donations, and event registrations.

### WEB DEVELOPMENT

- Wrote a CMS from scratch to accommodate nonstandard architecture. It featured a custom PHP MVC framework, PHP Documenter, and Apache Subversion. CMS had 7-years of service / 400 users / 4,000 pages of content.
- Created a unique college catalog system. Converted 300-page book to an online resource with an XML data source. PHP and XSLT allowed dynamic generation of richly formatted HTML or rich text and granular syndication of data. Planned workflow and trained catalog editors to manage XML.
- Wrote a PHP proxy using cURL. Before widespread RSS and iCal, this proxy allowed the College website to access, style, and display data from third-party tools.

### MARKETING & SOCIAL MEDIA

- Member of the taskforce responsible for the College's marketing plan. Helped create a style guide and administered visual identity. Participated in branding exercises, research, and authored a blog on marketing and higher education.
- Led new media initiatives on trending platforms. Shot, edited, and embedded videos in 2006. Trained students to create podcasts in 2007. Established presence on [Facebook](#), [YouTube](#), and [Flickr](#). Currently involved in efforts on [Instagram](#) and [Tumblr](#).
- Orchestrated successful email campaigns and published a monthly email newsletter for six years. Latest campaign, with responsive design and multivariate (A/B) testing, went to 90,000+ teens. Moving the campaign in-house improved response rates while saving the institution more than \$15,000.
